

The Ready4: A language we use to think, talk, train, and take action in the face of a RiskEvent.

Ready4Reason// The reason we might need to (O) get out, (P) protect ourselves and others, (T) treat an injury to ourselves and others, (S) get ourselves and others to shelter/safety.

Ready4Response// The first right thing to do during a RiskEvent ... and then the next one ... and the next one ... down the PATH to safety.

When a RiskEvent happens what are my/our OPTionS? Do we get Out, Protect, Treat, or Shelter

Out// Knowing when to get **out**, how to get **out**, and where to go.

Protect// Knowing when, how, and with what to **protect** ourselves and others.

Treat// Knowing when, how, and with what to **treat** an injury to ourselves and others.

Shelter// Knowing when, where, and how to get (or create) **shelter**/safesite.

What is the PATH out of this Risk Event? What is the Plan, Actions, Tools, and Help.

Plan// The **Plan** to solve the problem. Example: Building+Fire = Go down and Get out.

Actions// The **Actions** that are required to execute the Plan.

Tools// The **Tools** that are needed to perform the actions required to execute the Plan.

Help// How long it will take for expert **Help** to arrive.

Ready4 Snapshot: A method for quickly assessing/measuring the *reality* of a RiskEvent. There are 4 filters Ready4Reasons flow through allowing us to describe, discuss, and decide how to (a) reduce the probability of the event, or (b) respond effectively and collectively to the event.

Probability//	(best) 1/Unlikely	2/Possible	3/Probable	4/Imminent	(hardest)
Challenge//	(best) 1/Simple	2/Complicated	3/Complex	4/Chaotic	(hardest)
Availability//	(best) 1/Minutes	2/Hours	3/Day(s)	4/Unknown	(hardest)
Responsibility//	(best) 1/Self	2/Self+1to2	3/Self+3to5	4/Self+many	(hardest)

Ready4 Protect// BadActors+BadActions diagram: A simple method for “threat mapping” if we are guarding against or responding/reacting to a person who is a possible threat.

Bad Actor (the person)

Bad Action (the methodology)

Examples:

- Sophisticated - Sophisticated (Oceans 11, Thomas Crown Affair, etc ...)
- Opportunistic - Opportunistic (Oliver Twist, pickpocket, etc ...)
- Irrational - Irrational (Heavens Gate Cult, etc ...)
- Irrational - Sophisticated (Hannibal Lecter, Mitch Leary (John Malcovich’s character in the movie *Line of Fire* starring Clint Eastwood, Renee Russo, etc)
